

THE FLORA WOOTEN SMITH NURSING SCHOLARSHIP

Purpose	The purpose of the Flora W. Smith Scholarship is to provide a scholarship annually to a high school graduate who has indicated the desire to pursue an education in the field of nursing.
Inception	Mr. John Walter Smith, husband, and Karen Hall and Alyce Kaplan, daughters, have established a scholarship as a memorial to Flora Wooten Smith in honor of her forty-two years of dedicated service as a registered nurse.
Scholarship Fund	The scholarship fund was created in August, 1991 to be invested in an interest-bearing account as "The Flora Wooten Smith Scholarship Fund". The principle may be increased by future gifts from any donor at any time. The amount of the scholarship will be determined by the interest income available. The family of Flora W. Smith will supplement the interest in order for the scholarship to be at least \$300.00 each year. The first scholarship will be awarded on June 1, 1993 and annually thereafter.
Requirements	Recipient must: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. be a full-time student working toward a degree in Nursing2. priority will be given to members of Chadbourn Baptist Church, although recipients do not have to be a member of Chadbourn Baptist Church3. have earned a 2.0 GPA in previous educational work and maintain an acceptable level of work4. be selected by members of the Chadbourn Baptist Church Scholarship Committee5. be judged on his/her merit and achievement, leadership and service, character, academic standing and motivation
Application	Application for this scholarship must: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. be submitted by the applicant and should include the following details: name, current home address, social security number, name of high school and date of graduation, the college the applicant currently attends or plans to attend, the degree the applicant is pursuing or plans to pursue and why, current grade point average, academic achievements, church, school and community activities, honors and awards received, past and present place(s) of employment, reasons the applicant is deserving of the scholarship, and any other information the applicant would like the Scholarship Committee to know. Included with the above information must be a letter of recommendation written by a member of Chadbourn Baptist Church, excluding members of current Scholarship Committee or applicant's family and a copy of the applicant's latest transcript.2. be delivered to the church Administrative Assistant by April 30 for consideration by the Scholarship Committee
Disbursement	The money will be disbursed in equal increments according to the school's academic terms over a period of one school year. Should the recipient not continue to meet the criteria, the balance of the scholarship can be awarded to another student for the remainder of the school year. In the event the student withdraws from the college for more than a quarter/semester, excepting illness of the student, the college will be requested to return any remaining money.
