

THE HONEYCUTT SCHOLARSHIP

Purpose	The purpose of The Honeycutt Scholarship is to provide a scholarship to a high school graduate to further his/her education. In the event Chadbourn Baptist Church does not have a high school graduate, a college student can be considered for this scholarship to further his/her education.
Inception	Johnny & Kay Honeycutt established this scholarship as a memorial in honor of John H., Sr. and Martha N. Honeycutt and all their descendants. Chadbourn Baptist Church was their home church upon moving to Chadbourn.
Scholarship	The college will be paid through Chadbourn Baptist Church. The amount of the scholarship will be \$1,000.00. The first scholarship will be awarded on Graduate Recognition Sunday 2013 and annually thereafter.
Requirements	Recipient must: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. be a full-time student2. be a member of Chadbourn Baptist Church3. have earned a 2.0 or higher GPA in previous educational work and maintain an acceptable level of work4. be selected by members of the Chadbourn Baptist Church Scholarship Committee and acquire a recommendation from a high school guidance counselor and / or principal. For returning college students, this recommendation is waived.5. be judged on his/her merit and achievement, leadership, church involvement, service, character, academic standing and motivation by the CBC Scholarship Committee
Application	Application for this scholarship must: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. be submitted by the applicant and should include the following details: name, current address, email address, contact phone number, name of high school / college and date of graduation, college applicant currently attends or plans to attend, degree the applicant is pursuing or plans to pursue and why, a copy of the high school applicant's latest transcript and current grade point average, academic achievements, church, school and community activities, honors and awards received, past and present place(s) of employment, reasons the applicant is deserving of the scholarship, and any other information the applicant would like the Scholarship Committee to know. Included with the above information must be a letter of recommendation written by a member or non-member of Chadbourn Baptist Church, excluding members of the current Scholarship Committee or applicant's family.2. be delivered to the church Administrative Assistant by April 30 for consideration by the Scholarship Committee.
Disbursement	Scholarship will be paid to the college of recipient's choice. In the event the student withdraws from the college for more than a quarter/semester, excepting illness of student, the college will be requested to return any remaining money.
